



About the Program



A Two-Fold Path Toward Becoming Your Best Self



It provides students across the Faculty of Arts with the opportunity to become engaged in their community and work towards leadership skills that are essential for both academic and professional success. Students will also form meaningful relationships and build connections that will enrich their university experience.

Opportunity Categories



Learn About You

Students are encouraged to find workshops, events, or groups that cater towards their personal interest and promote personal growth. These workshops, events and groups vary depending on each students' specific interests and needs.



Engage With Your Community

By engaging with the community (both on and off campus), students are able to build a network of friends, support and allies. By becoming involved and supporting others, they give back to the community they are a part of and experience the fullness of campus life.



Apply Your Knowledge

Through the program, students are encouraged to apply skills attained in the classroom to real life scenarios and opportunities. This form of experiential learning allows for a deeper understanding of academic concepts.

Work/Volunteer

By taking part in various volunteer and work opportunities, students are able to further develop their skills and gain experience. Students will gain a variety of skills and competencies to build their resume and their career confidence.



Build Your Career

This portion is focused on encouraging students to sharpen and renew the skills they already have, and build the ones they may not, to better prepare and navigate the employment market.



Leadership Opportunities

Participating in leadership opportunities will require students to put the skills they have been developing in earlier stages to the test. In practicing these skills, students are setting themselves up to become the next generation of leaders/facilitators in their field and future careers.



Building Connections & Skills for Success.

This exciting first stage focuses on campus engagement, professional development, and community building. You will connect with peers and faculty members from other programs, departments, and faculties while learning useful skills such as resume building, networking, and design thinking. You will also have the opportunity to be coached in facilitation, project management, mentorship and leadership. In this advanced final stage, you will be encouraged to apply the skills you gained by taking on a leadership role with ambassadors from Stage 1. You will be immersed in an environment that cultivates and refines skills such as communication, leadership, mentorship, facilitation, content creation, and more! You will receive valuable feedback and coaching on your project management, public speaking, and professional leadership skills developed in practical settings.
