

## International Economics and Finance, MA CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

All students must complete the Mathematics and Statistics Review (EF8100), four required courses, three electives, and one of the following: a research paper, an additional course or an internship. The following is typical academic year but can vary slightly as courses offered each term may change; students will need to adjust accordingly.

It is important to note that Fields of Study are informal only and are not reflected on transcripts.

### PATHS OF STUDY

The *typical* paths of study for full-time and part-time students are as follows:

Term	Full-time (12 months)	Part-time (24 months)
Fall (year 1)	EF8100, 4 required	EF8100, 1 or 2 required*
Winter (year 1)	3 electives	2 electives
Spring (year 1)	Research Paper or 1 Course or Internship	Begin Research Paper if applicable
Fall (year 2)		1 or 2 required*
Winter (year 2)		2 electives
Spring (year 2)		Research Paper or 1 Course

\*Required courses are rotated between day and evening offerings on a two-year cycle.

**Note:** Part-time students are permitted to take no more than 2 courses per term (the Mathematics and Statistics Review does not count, as it is a non-credit course).
