## **How to Comprehend & Critically Analyze a Text**

Reading Comprehension	
Skim to get the gist and overall meaning  Scan for specific detail	<ul> <li>Jot down 2/3 guiding questions focusing on the main ideas/concepts in the text to create purpose</li> <li>Read the introduction and conclusion</li> <li>Read topic sentences</li> <li>Do active reading: underline or highlight</li> <li>Write a few questions about the specific details you need to know</li> <li>Look for answers</li> <li>Note answers in phrases or short sentences (using point form)</li> </ul>
Read thoroughly for comprehension of ideas, concepts, theories	<ul> <li>Read from the beginning to the end of the text</li> <li>Underline important key words (and jargon) and phrases</li> <li>Try to understand the writer's main argument</li> <li>Ask questions during reading</li> <li>Attempt to answer your questions and quiz yourself after reading</li> </ul>
Elements of Critical Reading	
Interpretation	<ul> <li>Read to know the meaning of the ideas presented in a text</li> <li>What can you infer?</li> <li>What conclusion(s) can you draw?</li> </ul>
Analysis	<ul> <li>What assumptions is the author making?</li> <li>How has the author structured arguments and developed ideas in the text?</li> <li>Does the evidence support the author's arguments and conclusion?</li> </ul>
Synthesis	<ul> <li>Bring together points of analysis to support your results</li> </ul>
Evaluation	<ul> <li>Reading to evaluate the validity of ideas and content of the text; evaluation includes all other critical reading processes to find out the value of information presented through data and/or other evidence</li> </ul>
