



Knowledge Mobilization Committee



In English: Our knowledge translation and mobilization plan aims to further realize the ICCRP’s goal to further equitable intergenerational partnerships informed by child rights, and make progress toward effecting change in Canadian and international research, debate, policy, and practice. This strategy plans to build on extensive Knowledge Mobilization networks created by the ICCRP, to involve key partner organization personnel and co-researchers in governance, and knowledge mobilization strategies.

Em português: Os processos de tradução e mobilização de conhecimento visam concretizar a meta da ICCRP, ou seja, promover parcerias intergeracionais equitativas baseadas nos direitos da criança e fomentar mudanças nas pesquisas, debates, políticas e práticas no Canadá e internacionalmente. Para tanto, serão mobilizadas as extensas redes de conhecimento criadas pela ICCRP com o objetivo de envolver os profissionais das principais organizações parceiras e os copesquisadores nos processos de governança e formulação de estratégias para compartilhamento de conhecimento.

En español: Nuestro plan de traducción y movilización del conocimiento tiene como objetivo hacer realidad la meta del ICCRP de promover asociaciones intergeneracionales equitativas basadas en los derechos del niño, y avanzar hacia la consecución de cambios en la investigación, el debate, la política y la práctica canadienses e internacionales. Esta estrategia planea basarse en las amplias redes de movilización de conocimientos creadas por el ICCRP, para envolver al personal clave de las organizaciones asociadas y a los coinvestigadores en la gobernanza y en las estrategias de movilización de conocimientos.
