Co-op Students Earn an Hourly Wage of \$22.48

This is a special report based on data for all work terms secured during the period January 1, 2023 - April 30, 2024.

Students earned an average hourly wage of \$22.48, with the wage for 4th work term being 15% higher than the 1st.

Average Wage, by Work Term

	Work Term 1	Work Term 2	Work Term 3	Work Term 4+
Hourly	\$20.92	\$21.99	\$22.93	\$24.09
Monthly	\$3,033	\$3,188	\$3,324	\$3,493

There are some interesting differences, however, across industry sectors. The table below highlights the average wages, by industry, across all work terms, with Financial Services paying the highest average wage at \$25.12/hour.
