Working at Bombardier

Celebrating 80 years of creativity, growth and a relentless desire to innovate, Bombardier has grown from its beginnings as a family business in rural Quebec, Canada, to becoming the maker of the world's finest business jets.

Bombardier grew out of a young mechanic's inventive and entrepreneurial spirit. Born in 1907, Joseph-Armand Bombardier built his first "snow vehicle" at the young age of 15. His motivation? To help people travel across the snow-covered roads of rural Québec in Canada.¹

The company, over the years, grew into one of Canada's leading industrial companies, manufacturing transportation equipment. Bombardier is now a global leader in aviation, focused on designing, manufacturing, and servicing exceptional business jets.

Its shares are publicly traded on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE).2

With over US\$6B in revenue, Bombardier holds more than one-third of the world's business jet market. Bombardier has a worldwide fleet of approximately 5,000 aircraft in service with a wide variety of multinational corporations, charter and fractional ownership providers, governments, and private individuals.

According to Ibis world, industry revenue is expected to grow an annualized 9.7% to \$24.8 billion over the next several years to 2026. Despite the recent slowdown, the global economy is anticipated to recover over the next five years, increasing air travel and demand for industry products.⁴

Career Pathways at Bombardier

Co-op and Internship

According to Bombardier, they onboard 400 students each semester, from across Canada.5

New Graduate Program

Recently launched, the <u>new graduate program</u> at Bombardier focusses on recruiting CPA professionals but this is likely to expand over the next year.

Ted Rogers Students at Bombardier



Although HR/OB students were the most hired, students from other program streams, like Business Technology Management and Marketing, also secured roles.





Work Terms by Majors




The most common positions secured during this same two-year period were:


- 1 Human Resources Intern
