This positive trend is something you might consider when exploring sectors for part-time work/co-op work terms or full-time graduate roles.

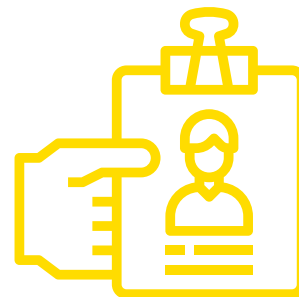
Top 20 Employers in Public Sector

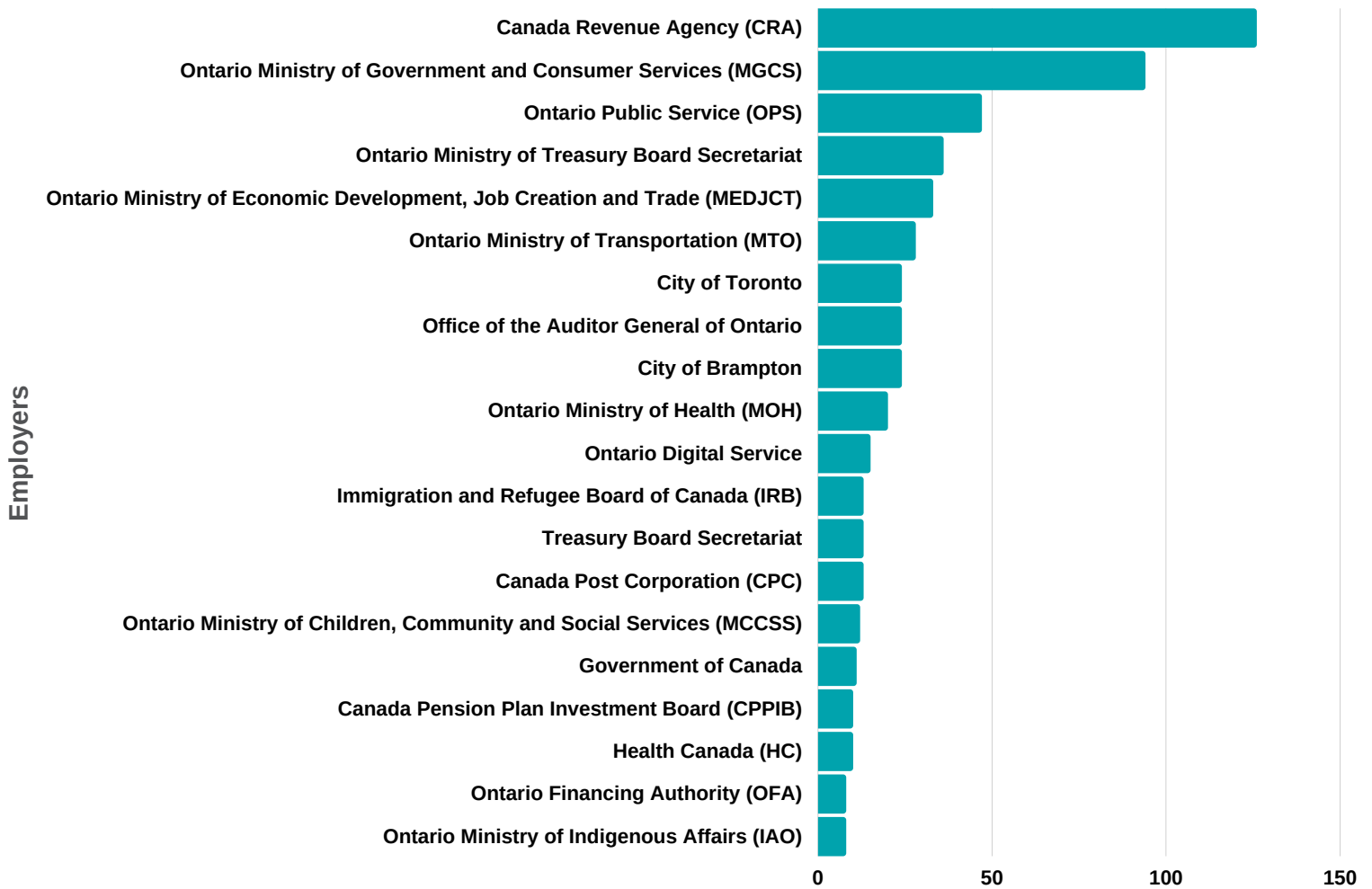
