Tips on Funding Your University Education

Many Students at Ryerson Access OSAP Funding

Did you know that there is nearly \$300 million in funding at Ryerson University to support students who require financial assistance? Most of this is in the form of OSAP funding, but the University also provides awards and bursary funding in the amount of \$34 million.

Approximately 75% of Ryerson University undergraduate students receive financial assistance through OSAP, so if you are receiving OSAP yourself or are thinking of applying, you are not alone.

- To apply to OSAP for 2021-2022, log into your OSAP account at ontario.ca/OSAP to create a brand new 2021-2022 application.
- The OSAP application uses a standard set of criteria to determine financial need (e.g. your family's income, your program costs, year of study, etc.)

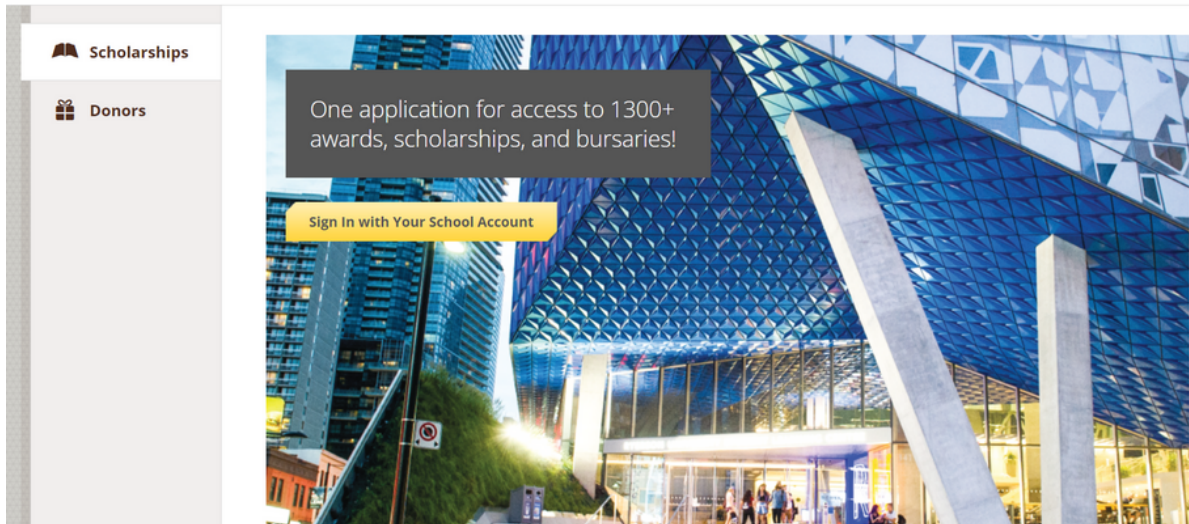
- OSAP loans need to be paid back - your first payment will be due 6 months after you graduate, and depending on how much you have borrowed, it may take you a number of years to pay the loan down in full - to get a sense of what your monthly repayment amount might be, [click here](#) to access a simple repayment model.

Bursaries and Financial Awards Are Also Available



During the 2020/2021 school year, **\$20 million** in continuing education, undergraduate and select university-wide graduate awards were administered to over **25,000** students!

Ryerson uses a platform called '[awardspring](#)' for students to apply for an award or bursary. The system vets your application and informs you of which awards you are eligible for. Ryerson alone offers more than \$20M in funding, none of which needs to be paid back, unlike OSAP.
