## **Typical Interview Questions**

Tell Me About Yourself (TIP: speak to your strengths)

Tell me about a time when you and a colleague or peer had miscommunication. What did you do and what was the outcome?

Have you ever had to "sell" an idea to your co-workers or group? How did you do it? What were the results?

### **Typical Interview Questions**

Tell me about a time when you have conflicting deadlines- how did you manage this?

How do you determine what amount of time is reasonable for a task?

How do you prioritize projects and tasks when scheduling your time?

#### **Typical Interview Questions**

What does your troubleshooting process look like?

If you had to choose between two or three options, how would you go about making a decision?

Describe a situation where you had to apply research skills to gather information necessary to solve a problem. How did you go about this?

Tell me about a project that you planned. How did you organize and schedule the tasks?

When has a project or event you organized not gone according to plan? What happened? What did you take away?
